City & Temples Tour

Daily: ~ 4 hours (Morning: 08.30 – 12.30 or Afternoon: 13.00 – 17.00)

Visit Wat Trimitr (Golden Buddha), Wat Po (Reclining Buddha) & Wat Benjamaborpitr (Marble Temple)

Grand Palace Tour

Daily excepted Sunday (Dusit Hall Closed): ~ 3 hours (Morning: 08.30 – 11.30 or Afternoon: 13.00 – 16.00)

Visit the Royal Palace to see Dusit Hall (Funeral Hall) and the holy Wat Phra Kaew (Emerald Buddha)

Grand Palace & Temples

Klongs (Canals) Tour

Daily: ~ 4 hours (Morning: 08.30 – 12.30 or Afternoon: 13.00 – 17.00)

Boat ride along the 'River of Kings' and its quiet canals. Also visit Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn)

Klongs (Canals) and Grand Palace

Daily excepted Sunday (Dusit Hall Closed): ~ 3 hours (Morning: 08.30 – 11.30 or Afternoon: 13.00 – 16.00)

Boat ride along the 'River of Kings', and its quiet canals. Also visit Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn), the Royal Palace to see Dusit Hall (Funeral Hall) and the holy Wat Phra Kaew (Emerald Buddha)
