

Samui Island Tour

Daily, except Monday: 4 hours (Morning 08:30 hrs – 13:30 hrs / or Afternoon 13:00 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

This trip provides the perfect opportunity to get a true feel for the island and see for yourself, the unspoiled beauty of Samui. We'll take you to spectacular view points including the famous "Grandmother and Grandfather Rocks" (in Thai, Hin Ta and Hin Yai), well known as twin grotesque rocks on shore, and pass through a coconut plantation to watch monkeys picking coconuts (you can even try the fresh young coconuts which taste completely different from the older ones). Next, is a demonstration by the local people of how to make coconut milk by hand and perhaps you can try this by yourself. This tour is followed by a visit to small temple (Wat Kunaram), containing the mummified relic of a monk, who died and still, remains in the lotus position. Before our last stop, we head down to admire the beauty of the Na Muang waterfall (No.1) The last stop is Nathon, the island's main town, where you'll have time to wander around the shops. On the way back to the hotel, we'll stop and visit the Island's most memorable landmark, Big Buddha with its statue facing the surrounding bay. All the Samui highlights covered in half a day!

Angthong Marine Park *by big boat*

Angthong Marine Park *by Speedboat*

Daily: 8 hours (Morning 08:30 hrs – 16:30 hrs)

Angthong is the second National Park created in Thailand and it consists of around 40 curiously shaped islands. During this tour, we show you and let you experience the beautiful sights of Angthong National Park on this tour which departs from Nathon Pier and heads north by boat to an archipelago consisting of 42 islands, each with its own individual character. While here, you can explore natural caves, blue lagoons and stunning rock formations. This is followed by a trip to Mae Koh Island where the inner salt lake is located. Lunch will be served on the boat while we head to Wau Ta Lab Island and the National Park head quarters for sunbathing, swimming, snorkeling or just simply relaxing on the white sandy beach while taking in the breathtaking views around you. At the end of this wonderful day, you are convinced that Thailand is known for its extensive natural beauty and this is one of those examples you cannot miss out.

Koh Tao & Koh Nang Yuan by Speedboat

Daily: 8 hours (Morning 08:30 hrs – 16:30 hrs)

Two of Thailand's top idyllic islands on the east coast within easy reach! Enjoy a breathtaking day out to the beautiful island of Koh Tao on this tour which includes a transfer from your hotel to the pier to travel by speedboat to Koh Tao and Koh Nang Yuan. Your first stop is at Muang Bay on Koh Tao, a shallow dive site with lots of colorful fish where you can enjoy some snorkelling before enjoying lunch at a restaurant on another beach. Total peace and the feeling of being in another world. The crystal clear water offers a perfect visibility of the submarine life. After lunch, the speedboat takes you to the picture postcard island of Koh Nang Yuan three tiny islands connected by two strips of the whitest sand possible, allowing an easy passage from one to another. It is also possible to climb one of the hills to enjoy a panoramic view of the surroundings of this picturesque island. The return to Koh Samui is late in the afternoon, leaving paradise behind...

Mountain Safari & Elephant Trek

Monday, Wednesday and Friday: 8 hours (Morning 08:30 hrs – 16:30 hrs)

Starts as you board a 4WD vehicle and travel to a place where you can take a short elephant trek. Away from the hustle and bustle of city life, we ascend 630 meters into the jungle of Samui's hinterland, gradually climbing through banana, durian, mangosteen, rambutan and langsat plantations while seeing bamboo, wild ginger, galangal, frogs, spiders, colorful birds and butterflies and an occasional snake. During the ascent, the tour stops at a rubber plantation to see how rubber-tapping is done. Once we reach the summit of Samui and its magnificent panoramic views of all the surrounding islands, it will be time to relax with a sumptuous Thai lunch surrounded by the sounds of nature. After some exploring, we descend through the tropical jungle and rain forest and stop at Giant Valley View for a coffee break before arriving at Na Muang Waterfall, where you can take a refreshing swim in the cool fresh water surrounded by tropical rain forests before returning to your hotel.
