

HALF DAY EXCURSIONS:

Phuket City Tour

€ 15 P/P

Daily: 4 hours (Morning 09:00 hrs – 13:00 hrs / or Afternoon 13:00 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

This orientation tour is designed to give visitors to Phuket a nice introduction to the island without forcing them to invest in a full-blown excursion. The trip features a road tour that passes by Phuket's most famous beaches; a visit to the acclaimed Chalong Temple; a short outing from out of Phuket Town, famed for its Portuguese architecture. Loved by both Asian as well as foreign visitors, the temple's highlight is a wax sculpture of the abbot housed in an air-conditioned Thai-style house next to the chapel. We also provide you with the chance to see the most famous lookout point on the island - Promthep Cape. Additionally, guests who like to shop will not be disappointed as stops at local gemstone and cashew nut factories are also on the agenda. Phuket remains an outstanding holiday destination, not only due to its large variety of beaches, yet also due to its cultural importance to the southern part of Thailand.

4 IN 1 Safari (No Junk Cruise)

Daily: 4-5 hours (A.M. 08:00 hrs – 13:00 hrs > Lunch included / or P.M. 13:00 hrs – 17:00 hrs > Dinner included)

Travelers with a taste for adventure will enjoy this exciting excursion featuring several fascinating glimpses of nature. The outing begins with a four-wheel drive jeep ride to an elephant camp on the Chalong highlands for a chance to ride these majestic beasts and take in the superb island views. This trip will also prove to be educational as well as adventurous, as guests on the trek learn all about elephants and a conservation project to protect them, and see how they are trained and cared for. Next up is a jeep safari into the Chalong highlands with more great views of Phuket Island and an opportunity to witness a demonstration on how to make Thai jungle curry at a local Thai house. This is followed by a visit to a rubber plantation to see how natural rubber is produced and a fascinating look at how monkeys are trained to pick coconuts for the locals. This memorable tour concludes with a ride by a traditional buffalo cart that takes guests to either a delicious buffet lunch or dinner that everyone will surely enjoy.

FULL DAY EXCURSIONS: Include Lunch

Phang Nga Island by Coach

Daily: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs) > Admission Fee to the National Park is included

This exciting, all-day excursion takes visitors to the unique and spectacular seascape of Phang Nga (75 kilometres northeast of Phuket), one of nature's most unusual and beautiful locations, and the site of the 1974 James Bond film "The Man With The Golden Gun" (starring Roger Moore as '007' and Christopher Lee as the title character). This full-day tour departs from Phuket in an air-conditioned coach to enjoy more amazing scenery including the dramatic limestone mountains of Panak Island and Hong Island, before approaching Koh Tapu which has become known as 'James Bond Island.' From there, the boat outing continues through the mangrove and silent caves with many strangely shaped limestone rocks, with cliff faces that seemingly rise majestically straight up from the sea. An afternoon lunch will be served at Koh Pannnyi (also known as Sea Gypsy Island) which is built over the water on stilts, before the day concludes, regrettably, at your booked hotel in Phuket.

Phang Nga Bay & Koh Khai by Speed boat

Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

This exciting, all-day excursion takes visitors to the unique and spectacular seascape of Phang Nga, one of nature's most unusual and beautiful locations, and the site of the 1974 James Bond film "The Man With The Golden Gun," (starring Roger Moore as 007 and Christopher Lee as the title character). From there, guests depart from Laem Sai in a speedy luxury cruiser to enjoy more amazing scenery including the dramatic limestone mountains of Panak Island and Hong Island, before approaching Koh Tapu which has become known as 'James Bond Island.' From there, the boat outing continues through the mangrove and silent caves, with cliff faces that seemingly rise majestically straight up from the sea. Sea Canoeing in Phang Nga Bay

Daily: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

This full day of adventure and excitement begins as visitors depart from Laem Sai Pier and jettison off to Phang Nga Bay on a cruiser boat. Upon arrival, they will be able to explore sea caves and tunnels, and lagoons by special 'sea-canoes'. Discover a unique and hidden world as sturdy canoes weave their way through a network of brilliant crystalline limestone caves, to reveal the mysterious hidden world of the "Hong" (or rooms, these are collapsed cave system inside the rock) Each interior of each island is different and provides a whole new atmosphere, only accessed by tough, purpose-designed inflatable canoes through sea-caves at low tide. Upon returning to the cruiser, the adventurers will enjoy a Thai buffet lunch on board while slowly cruising to Lawa Island, where they can enjoy swimming, canoeing or sun-bathing on the sandy beach, before returning to Phuket.

Similan Islands by Speed boat

Wednesday, Friday & Sunday: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

One of Thailand's National Marine Parks, the Similan Islands are located in the junction between the Andaman Sea and the Indian Ocean. The 9 islands, covering an area of approximately 130 square kilometres, were created from volcanic activity some 65 million years ago, smoothed by glacial ice and now stand as a granite-based, foliage covered, and coral loving tropical paradise. Located around 90 kilometers northwest of Phuket, Similan has gained great fame as a prime diving location and is consistently rated as one of the top international dive sites in the world. With an abundance of marine life, crystal clear water and attractive coral formations, guests will marvel at the natural beauty as they engage in a variety of activities including snorkelling or simply relaxing on the white sandy beaches and enjoying a delicious National Park Restaurant lunch.

Phi Phi Islands Tour by Cruiser

Daily: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

Within a short distance by comfortable boat, you reach one of these tropical islands in the Andaman Sea; you have heard of yet never had the chance to visit. This amazing adventure starts in the early morning as guests set out by Cruiser Boat from the Rassada Pier to the scenic Phi Phi Islands (Phi Phi Don and Phi Phi Le), located about 45 kilometers from Phuket. Sightseeing excursions include Lho Sa Mah and Phi Ley cove as well as Maya Bay, where the 2000 film "The Beach" (starring Leonardo DiCaprio and Tilda Swinton) was filmed. A chance to observe the majestic undersea world is also available for guests who enjoy snorkelling. If you are more the exploring type and Phi Phi's natural beauty is not enough, there is plenty to do on and off the island. Phi Phi Ley is home to the Viking Cave, a large limestone cavern, where ancient rock paintings can be found. Thought to resemble Viking ships – hence the name of the cave – they are predicted to be 3000 to 4000 years old. This is a perfect spot to experience the colours and rhythms of this tropical hideaway.

Phi Phi Islands Tour by Speedboat

White Water Rafting and Elephant Trek

Daily: 9 ½ hours (07:30 hrs – 17:00 hrs)

After getting picked up from your hotel, you'll stop at the Phang Nga Wildlife Breeding Center on your way to the Phang Nga province. Once there, you'll explore the Tone Pariwat Wildlife Sanctuary Station and commence with an exciting white water rafting tour before enjoying lunch at a local restaurant. Next, is a visit to an elephant camp for a 30-minutes trek through the jungle on one of these majestic animals is something everybody will really enjoy! The elephant is Thailand's working pride and one of this country's national symbols. Current estimates of wild elephants left in Thailand were between 3000-4000 animals. Although logging is being banned in this Kingdom, they remain a very important mode of jungle transport as it beats any other animal or machine for its ability to move through a forest with minimum damage. A ride on a four-wheel-drive vehicle, jungle walking and swimming in the crystal clear water at Nature Waterfall are other activities that can be enjoyed here. Soft drinks, coffee or tea will be served before the return trip to Phuket where you'll be transferred to your hotel.
